CCRP Bylaws, ARTICLE IX - VOTING AND PROXIES

SECTION A - All voting members who are present in person, or by proxy, have the right to vote on all matters coming before the CCRCC or the Executive Board, unless the proxy shall expressly state otherwise in writing.

SECTION B - Any voting member may give a proxy for any regular or special meeting (from which they are excused). Proxy forms shall be available for download from the CCRCC web site.

SECTION C - To be valid, a completed proxy form shall be dated and signed by the member, designating the proxy holder by name or as bearer. At each meeting, the Chairman shall instruct the Secretary to examine all proxy forms and validate the signatures and declare the names of those voting by proxy. Challenges to proxies shall be the first item of business.

SECTION D - No person shall exercise more than two proxies at a Membership Meeting, or one proxy at an Executive Board meeting.

SECTION E - CCRCC members may give their proxy to any CCRCC member or Associate Member in good standing. Any Executive Board member may give their proxy to another Executive Board member in good standing.

Note: The proxy grants voting rights but is not to be used as a ballot
